



“Things We Can Know About Jesus” by Noel Heikkinen

This is a summary of a 5-month study I conducted on the word "Christ" in the New Testament.

Here's what I recommend. Print this study out, find a spot alone and read it straight through (out loud if you can pull it off). Pray before you start that God would make the truth about His Son very real to you in the process. With hindsight, I wish I had included the specific Scripture references for each of these, but you can make it part of your study to find them. Just find your favorite concordance (you can use <http://www.studylight.org>) and search for “Christ.”

- God's unfailing love and faithfulness came through Him.

- He works power through our weaknesses.
